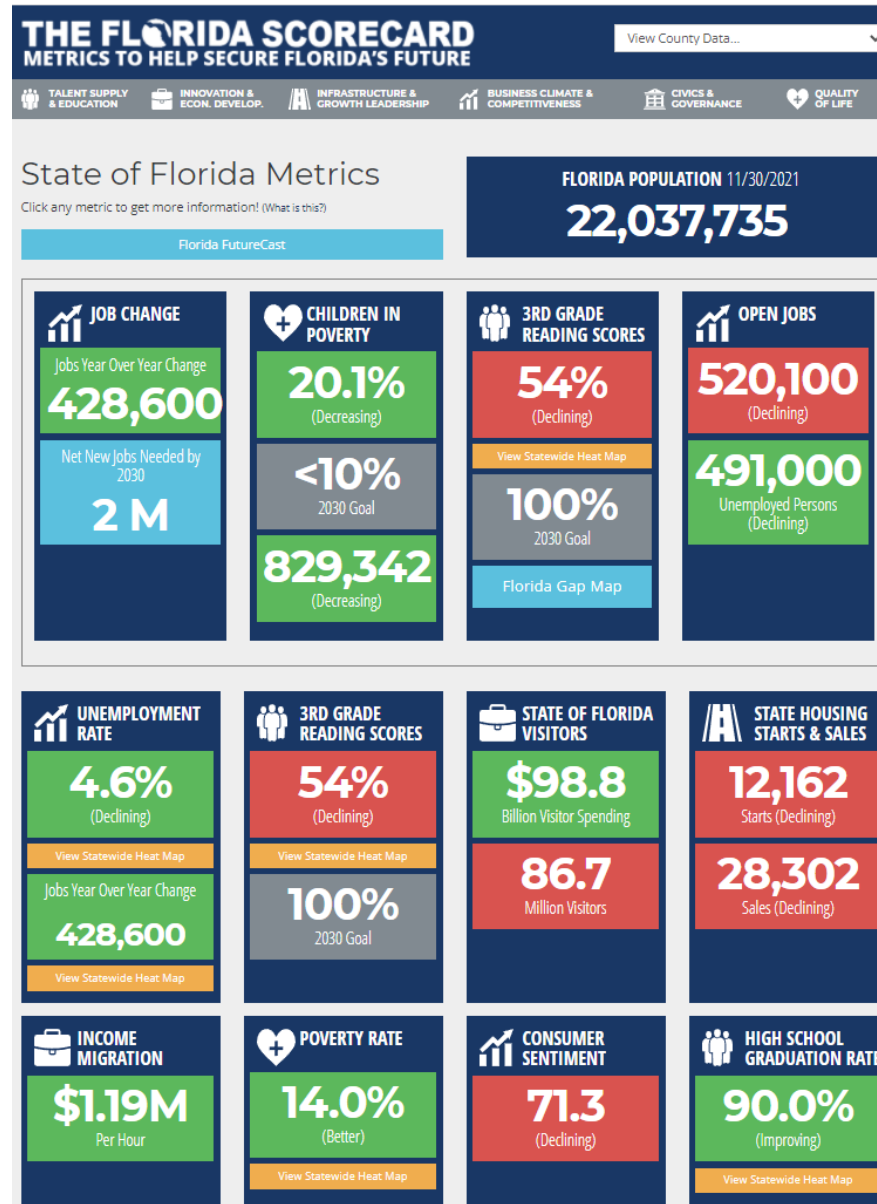

Florida population now more than 22 million

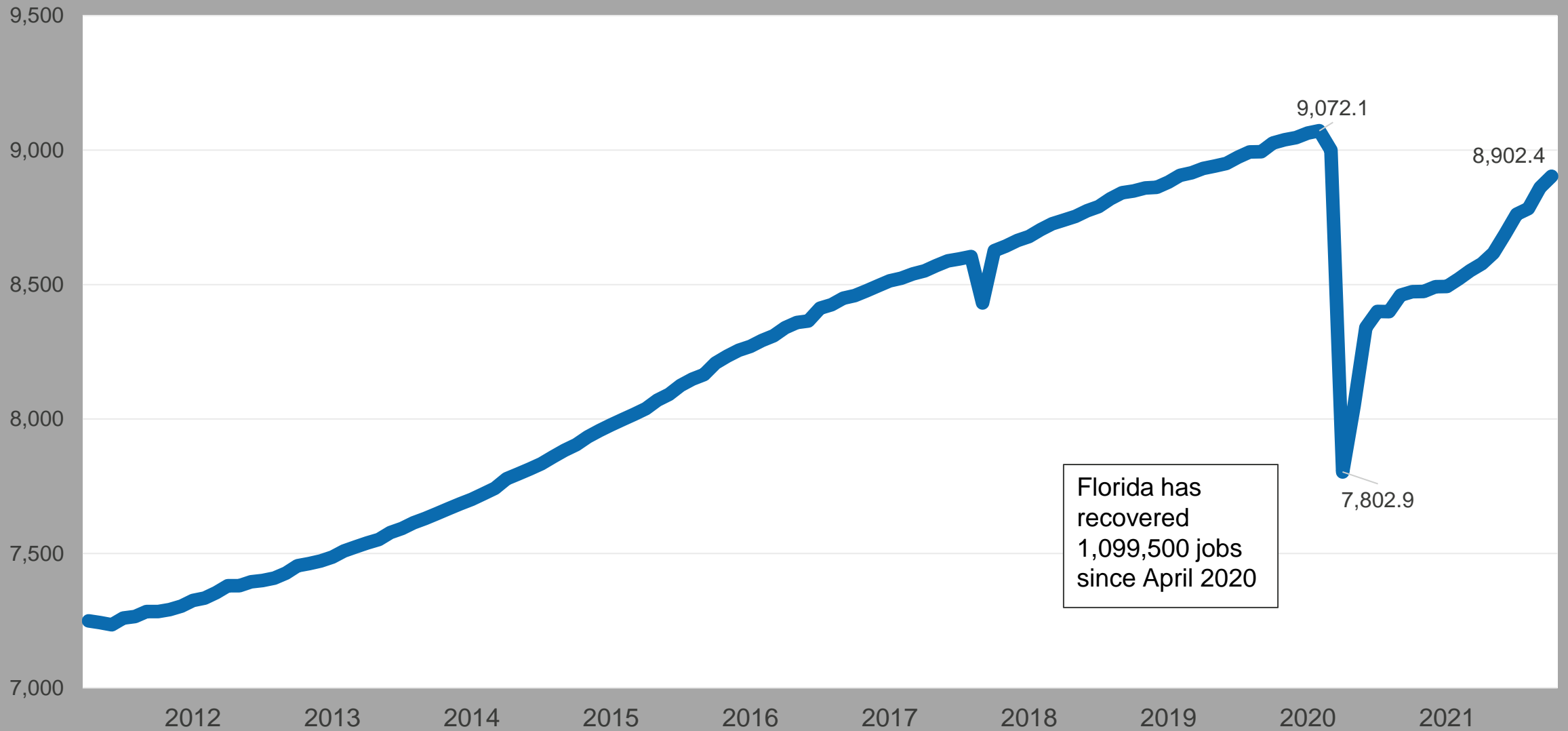
Net +800 people/day

520,100 open jobs currently in Florida



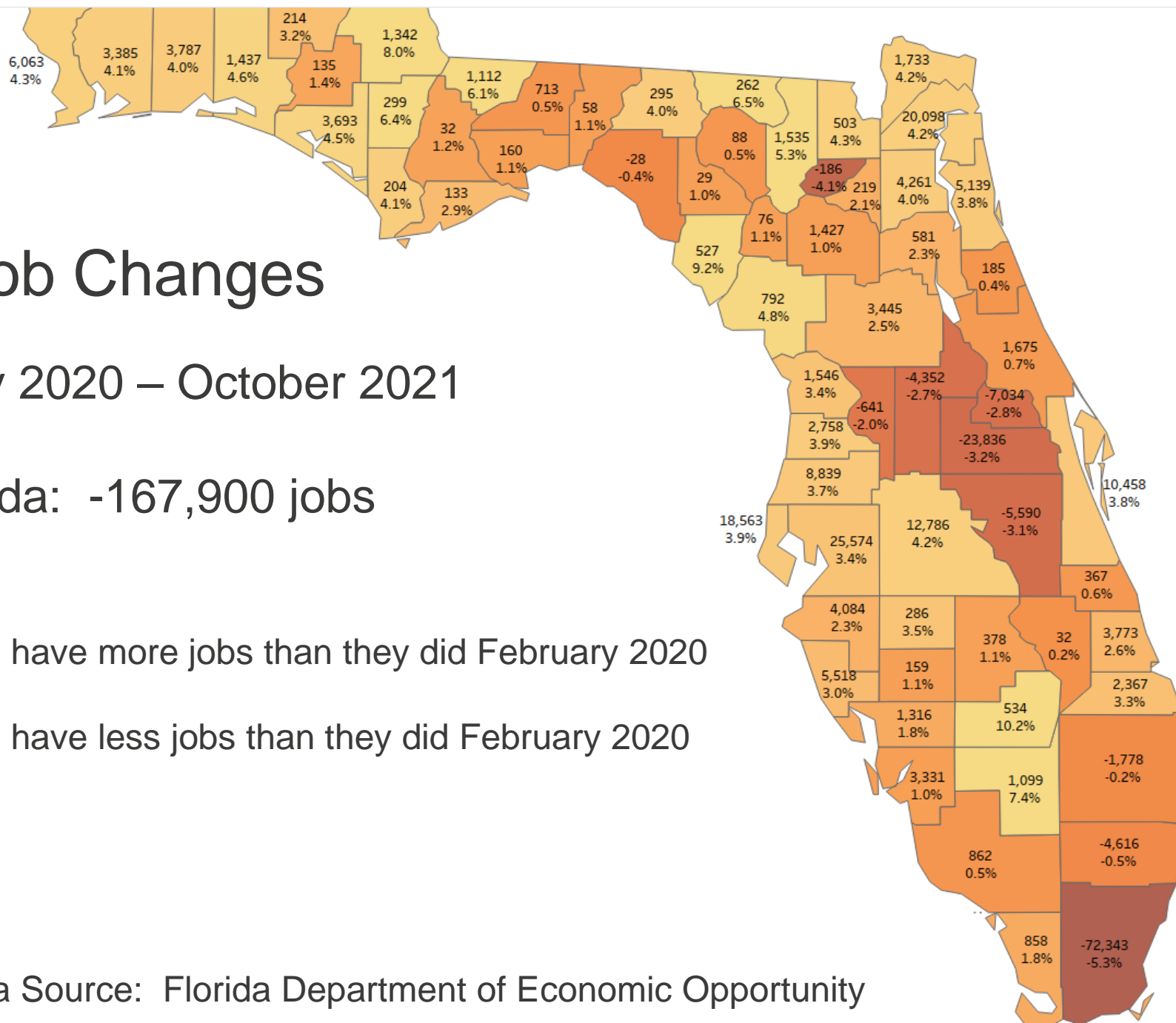
# Florida non-farm Jobs, seasonally adjusted (thousands)



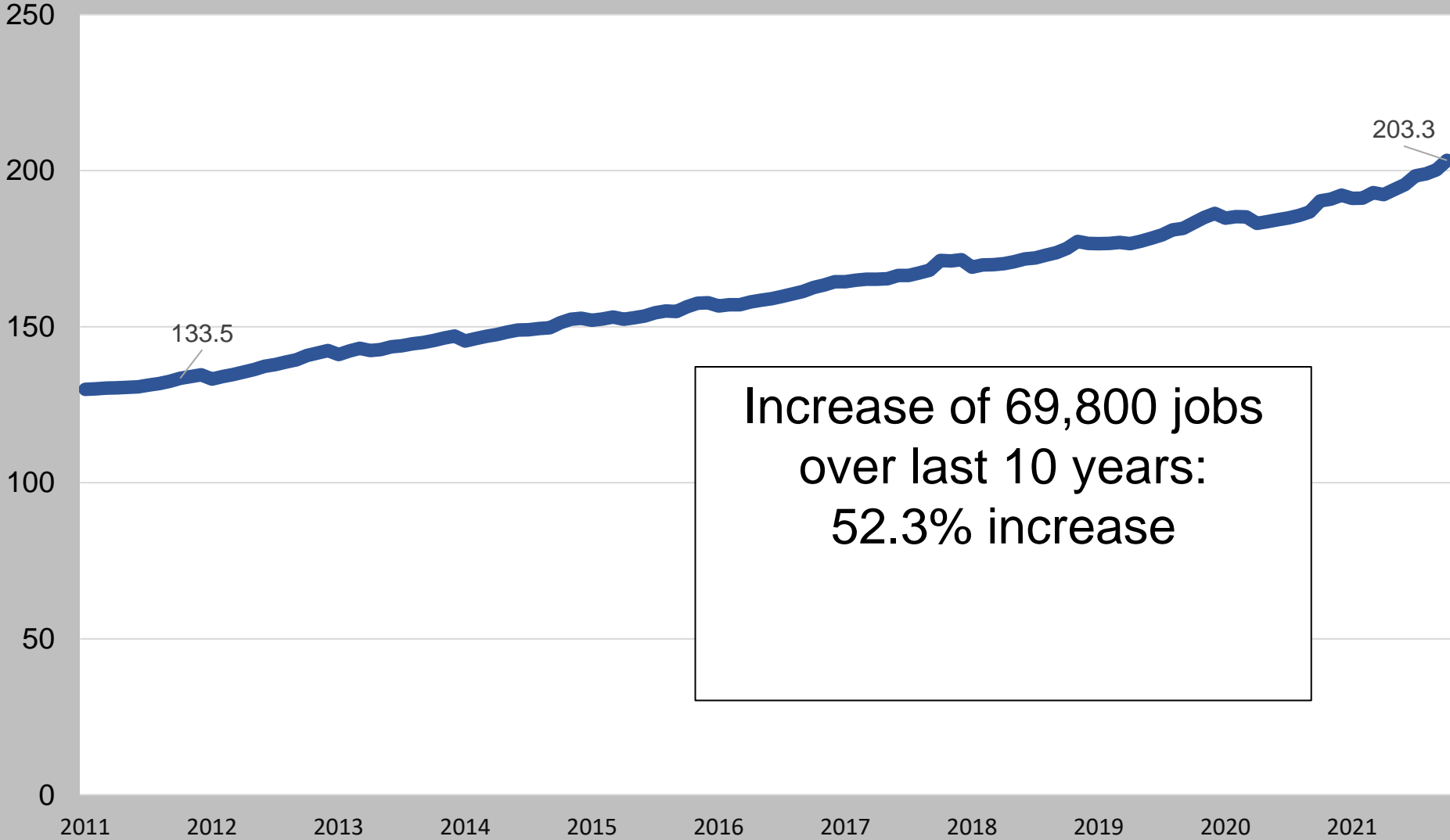
Florida has recovered 1,099,500 jobs since April 2020

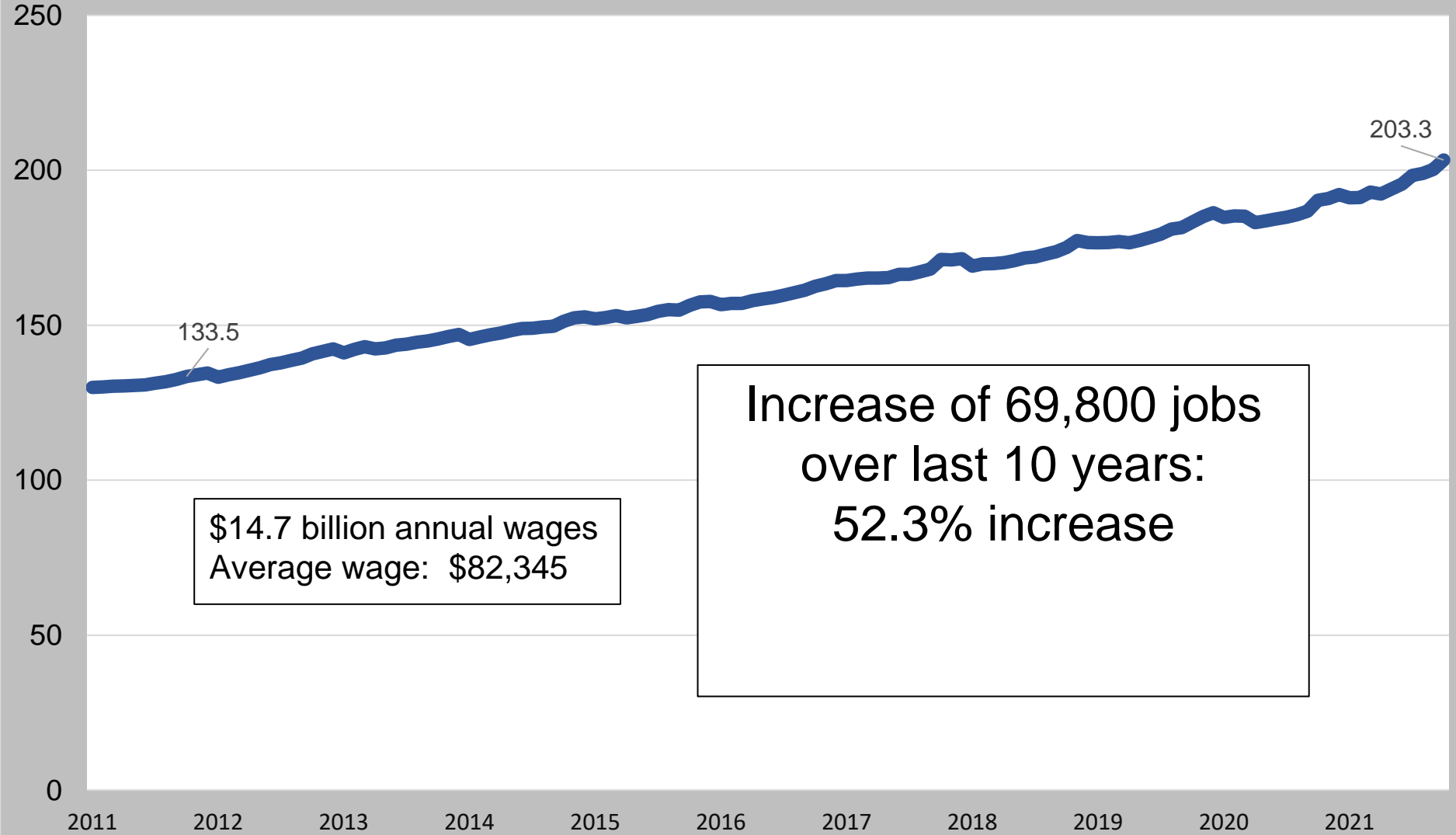

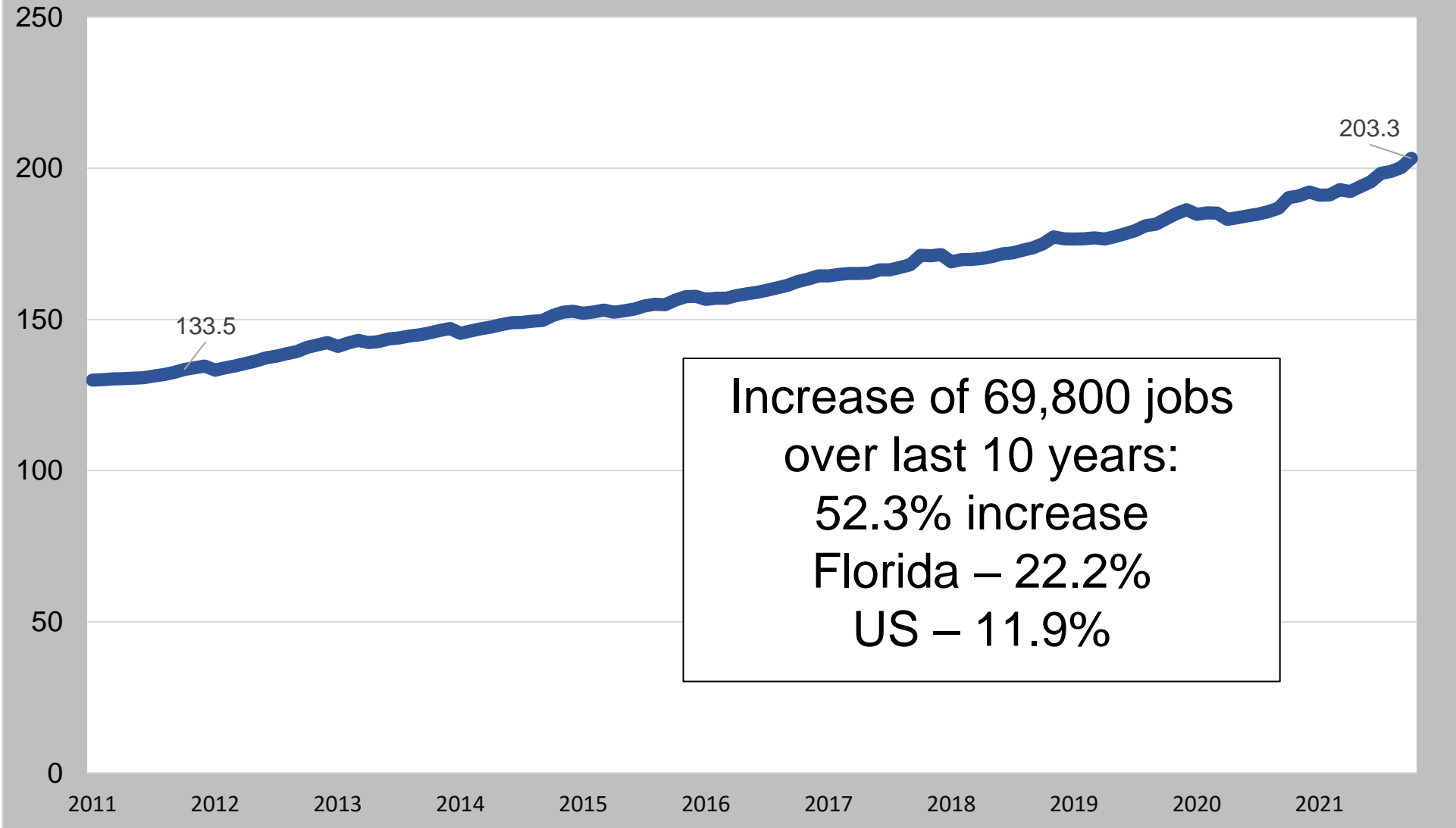

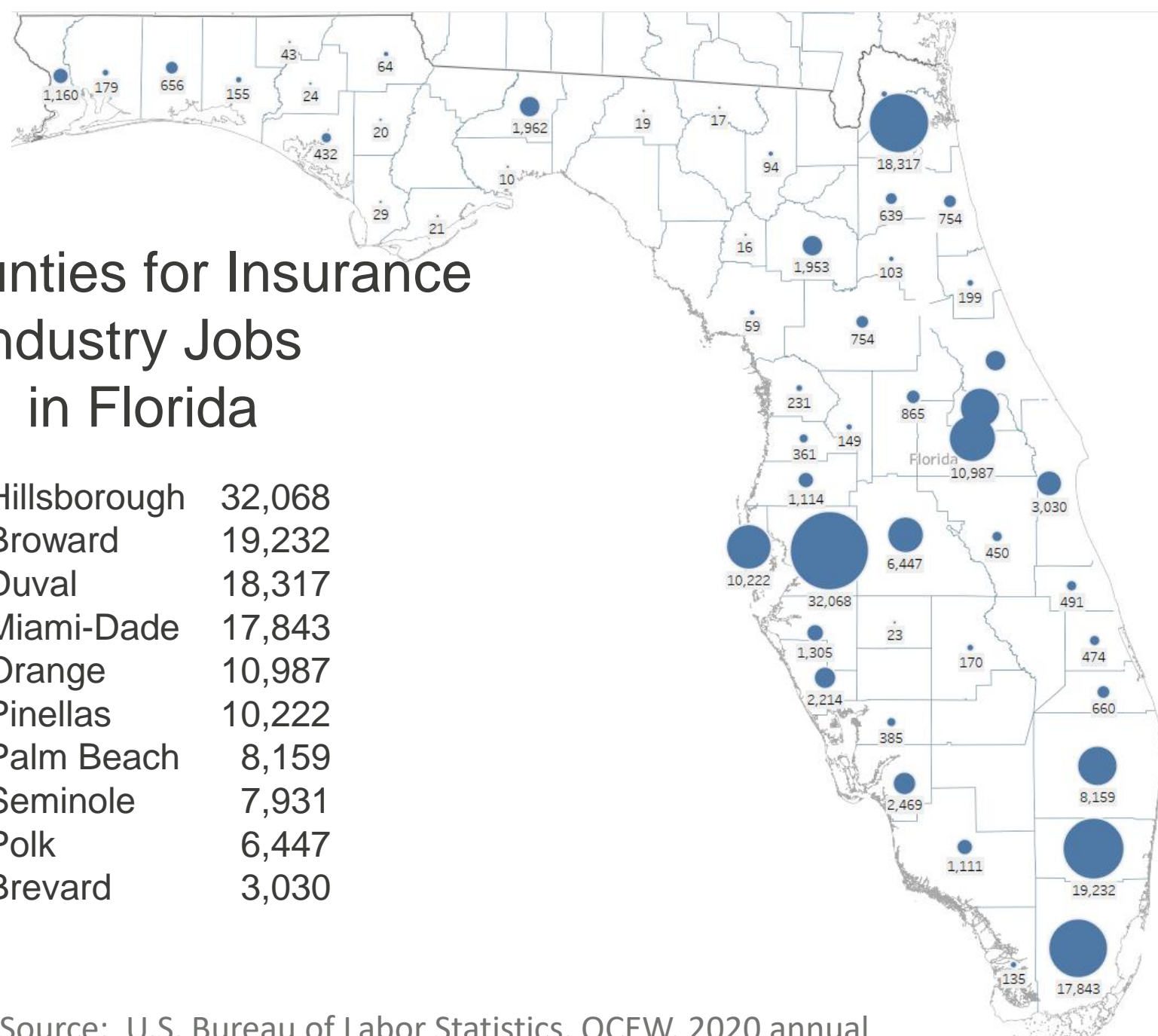
