WHEREAS, Floridians live in a state that promotes safe and healthy workplaces; and

WHEREAS, the National Safety Council, was congressionally chartered in 1953 to lead the nation in injury prevention through safety and health information, education, training, and advocacy; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Chamber Safety Council, founded in 2020, is the official state chapter of the National Safety Council, and is the state's leading provider of workplace safety training; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Chamber Safety Council offers training webinars and resources to Florida businesses to help improve the safety of Florida's workplaces on topics such as active shooter and threat management, anti-human trafficking, OSHA standards and compliance and workplace mental health; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Chamber Safety Council is making Florida the safest, healthiest and most sustainable state in America through being an incubator of safety initiatives and best practices, and the go-to resource for safety, health, and sustainability and is becoming the national standard for safety leadership; and

WHEREAS, in June 2022, the National Safety Council and Florida Chamber Safety Council are providing Florida with a month-long public education campaign during the summer season; and

WHEREAS, the National Safety Council recognizes this annual observance to help keep each other safe from the workplace to anyplace.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor and Cabinet of the State of Florida do hereby proclaim June 2022 as

NATIONAL SAFETY MONTH

in the State of Florida, and encourage all workplaces and organizations to access all available resources and tools to recognize signs of impairment and to prevent injuries and deaths and to identify hazards and assess risks.

WHEREFORE the Governor and the Cabinet of the State of Florida have hereunto subscribed their names and have caused the Official Seal of the State of Florida to be hereunto affixed in the City of Tallahassee on this 1st day of June 2022.
